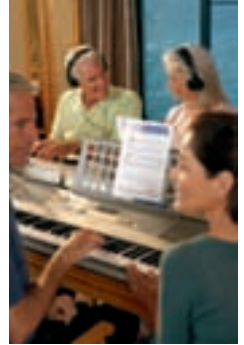

THE CANARY ISLANDS

Upon arriving, they encountered the local people who kept wild dogs as protection. "Canis," Latin for dog, became the basis for its current name.

In the 1400s, the islands became part of the Spanish Colony and it's been said that Christopher Columbus stopped here in 1492 en route to the New World. Many historians also believe this may be the site of the lost continent Atlantis. Today, travelers journey to the Canary Islands for its sheer beauty and natural wonders. Tenerife, the largest island, is home to a remarkable array of flora and fauna, a volcano, rugged coastlines, archaeological wonders, pristine beaches and bustling ports — which make it a favorite destination for visitors worldwide.
