**AHI Connects: Celebrate Swiss Culture.** While enjoying regional cuisine, a local folkloric singing group entertains you with Swiss folk songs and the Alpenhorn, an instrument traditionally used by Swiss herdsmen.

**Lake Oeschinen.** Hop on a train to Kandersteg, where jagged peaks and glaciers frame the village's dark-timber chalets. Pass grazing cows and sheep during a gondola ride up the mountain. Then stretch your legs during a hike to the turquoise Lake Oeschinen.

**Bern.** Fountains, historic towers and sandstone facades adorn the capital city. Some of the city's most popular sites include the Clock Tower, Einstein House and the Cathedral of Bern, a stunning example of late Gothic architecture.

**Brienzer Rothorn.** Travel to Brienz, renowned for its traditional wood carving. Take the steam-powered train to the summit of Brienzer Rothorn, where a stunning mountain vista awaits you. After, cruise Lake Brienz to Interlaken.

**Lauterbrunnen Valley.** Ride aboard the train to the Lauterbrunnen Valley and walk along a scenic trail to Winteregg and Mürren. On a clear day, witness the iconic North Face of the Eiger peak, as well as Mönch and Jungfrau. Descend by cable car from Mürren, enjoying the majestic emerald landscapes.

**Grindelwald and Rosenloui Glacier Gorge.** Visit the resort town of Grindelwald, a summer playground for walkers, hikers and cyclists. In the winter, the village become a haven for skiing enthusiasts. Absorb your surroundings before taking a Swiss PostBus, part of Switzerland's extremely efficient rail system, through a high mountain pass. After lunch, tackle the trail that parallels the Weissenbach River, which rushes through the narrow gorge created by an ancient glacier.

**Alpine Dining.** Step into the Hotel Rosenloui, one of the oldest Alpine hotels, for a delicious lunch of traditional cuisine. The hotel traces its history to the 18th century, when the fledgling tourism industry emerged in the Swiss Alps.

Enrichment

**Mountaineering.** Switzerland enjoys a long tradition of mountain climbing. Learn about this popular pastime, which draws enthusiasts eager to tackle the challenging peaks of the Swiss Alps.

**Essential Switzerland.** Discuss the iconic elements of Swiss culture.

**Wines of Switzerland.** Sample Swiss wines as you learn about the country's wine industry. Nearly all Swiss wine remains in Switzerland.
