DISCOVERY

Welcome to Killarney! Join your Travel Director for a Killarney orientation tour, and pop into a pub for a tasty brew.

Killarney National Park – Carriage and Cruise. Ramble through the Killarney National Park aboard a traditional, horse-drawn jaunting car, followed by a leisurely boat trip.

Dingle Peninsula. Traverse the breathtaking Dingle Peninsula. Visit The Blasket Centre, which honors people who lived on the remote Blasket Islands until the mid-1900s. Relax over warm scones and beverages, followed by a drive along Sleah Head Drive. This coastal road is a highlight on the untamed Wild Atlantic Way.

Whiskey Tasting. Satisfy your taste buds with local whiskey flavors as an expert explains whiskey production.

The Gift of Gab. Visit Blarney Castle and see the Blarney Stone. Tradition holds that those who kiss the stone will be endowed with eloquence. Spend time in the castle’s lovely, extensive gardens.

Field-to-Fork Dining. Savor a special “field-to-fork” dining experience prepared by the chef-owner of Longueville House, a family-owned country estate. Your lunch showcases the flavors of freshly picked produce from the estate’s gardens and farm.

Kenmare. The quaint village of Kenmare boasts colorfully painted houses and shops. Gather for afternoon tea with fresh scones, pastries and clotted cream. Pass through Moll’s Gap and Ladies View to take in vistas of the pristine Killarney Lakes. Tour Muckcross House, a grand Victorian mansion that boasts extensive gardens near the shores of Muckcross Lake.

Ring of Kerry. Journey along one of the world’s most beautiful coastal drives. Explore charming local villages and take in views of the pristine Killarney Lakes. Watch border collies maneuver a flock of sheep during a demonstration. Then meet the local shepherd and ask questions about the dogs, farm life and the flock.

ENRICHMENT

History and Legends of the Kingdom of Kerry. Hear the history of Kerry from the Celtic Tribes, and learn about legends, royal visits and rebellions.

Irish Music. Delight in a special session with a local musician and join in singing along to some Irish tunes.


