DISCOVERY

Welcome to Killarney! Join your Travel Director for a Killarney orientation tour, and pop into a pub for a tasty brew.

Killarney National Park—Carriage and Cruise. Delight in a jaunting car tour, an Irish tradition that provides a historical look at Killarney along with jovial story telling and local folklore. During your ride, see the 15th-century medieval Ross Castle, and the gorgeous lakes and mountains of the region.

Dingle Peninsula. Traverse the breathtaking Dingle Peninsula. Visit The Basket Centre, which honors people who lived on the remote Basket Islands until the mid-1900s and the literary legacy they left behind. Relax over warm scones and beverages, then enjoy sweeping mountain vistas and scenery on Slea Head Drive, a highlight on the untamed Wild Atlantic Way, one of Europe’s most captivating coastal roads.

Whiskey Tasting. Satisfy your taste buds with local whiskey flavors as an expert explains whiskey production.

The Gift of the Gab. Visit Blarney Castle and see the famous Blarney Stone. Tradition holds that those who kiss the Blarney Stone will be endowed with eloquence, or the gift of the gab. Spend time revelling in the castle’s acres of gardens, waterways and arboretums.

Field-to-Fork Dining. Savor a special “field-to-fork” dining experience prepared by the chef-owner of Longueville House, a family-owned country estate. Your lunch showcases the flavors of freshly picked produce from the estate’s gardens and farm.

Kenmare. The quaint village of Kenmare boasts colorfully painted houses and shops. Gather for Afternoon Tea with fresh scones, pastries, clotted cream and more. Pass through Moll’s Gap and Ladies View to take in vistas of the pristine Killarney Lakes. Tour Muckross House, a grand Victorian mansion that boasts extensive gardens near the shores of Muckross Lake.


