Discovery

AHI Connects: Field to Fork. Savor a special “fresh from the farm” dining experience prepared by the chef-owner of Longueville House using the estate’s home-grown produce.

Ennis Tour. Delve into the history and folklore of County Clare’s capital city.

The Burren. Witness this striking rocky landscape of limestone pavements and diverse flora. Enjoy a presentation at the Burren Centre, then follow local expert Tony Kirby on a fascinating walk.

The Cliffs of Moher. Stand before the Poulnabrone Dolmen, a portal tomb from 2500-2000 B.C. Drive along the coast to the majestic Cliffs of Moher, which rise 700 feet above the Atlantic Ocean.

Aran Island of Inishmore. Take a ferry across Galway Bay to the largest of the Aran Islands, and explore this starkly beautiful locale where people have lived since the Stone Age. Visit the ruins of Dún Aonghasa and admire the scenic view.

Loop Head Peninsula. Relish stunning, rugged scenery as you travel the Loop Head Drive between the ocean and the Shannon Estuary. Gaze at scenic vistas from the Loop Head Lighthouse.

Dingle Peninsula. En route to Killarney, travel via picturesque Dingle Peninsula. Take a ferry ride and savor the coastal views. Visit The Blasket Centre, which honors the island’s former residents.

Jaunting Car Ride and Cruise. Ramble through Killarney National Park in a traditional, horse-drawn jaunting car, then delight in a pleasant boat trip.

Ring of Kerry. Journey along one of the world’s most beautiful coastal drives. Explore charming local villages and take in views of pristine Killarney Lakes.

Longueville House. Meet the owners of this family-run hotel set on a 500-acre country estate, who will share how they revitalized the farm, gardens and orchard to achieve their field-to-fork vision.

Rock of Cashel. Visit this atmospheric landmark, once the seat of kings such as Brian Boru. It later became a notable medieval religious site, and the remains of the church buildings are a standout.

Cosmopolitan Dublin. On a panoramic tour, revel in the city’s captivating mix of historic architecture, lush gardens, parks and cobblestone streets.

Enrichment

Irish Music and Dance. Tap your foot to the lively beat of a traditional céilí band, accompanied by dancers, during an exclusive show.

Irish Seanchaí. Listen as Eddie Lenihan, a seanchaí—an Irish storyteller—relates folk stories in the time-honored style.

Sheep Herding. Watch border collies maneuver a flock of sheep during a demonstration, then meet the shepherd for a chat about the dogs and the flock.

Irish Literature. Dublin is a UNESCO City of Literature. Learn about the figures who shaped its literary heritage.
