DISCOVERY

Tel Aviv's Ancient Port of Jaffa.

Explore the pretty port of Old Jaffa. Visit a colorful market and an artist's studio. Then walk through the artsy Neve Tzedek neighborhood.

Museum of the Jewish Diaspora.

Visit this intriguing museum, which traces the history of the dispersment of the Jewish people throughout the world and their return to Israel.

White City of Tel Aviv. Admire the beauty and limestone architecture of "The White City" on a panoramic tour.

The Mediterranean Coast. In Caesarea, see ancient Roman ruins, including an amphitheater, aqueduct and hippodrome. A multimedia presentation will offer insight into the area.

Ancient Akko. Stop at the Old City of Akko and visit the Crusader fort.

Upper Galilee. Journey by boat on the Sea of Galilee. Visit Tabgha, an ancient fishing village, and experience the scenic Mount of Beatitudes.

Flavors of Olive Oil. Tour an olive oil factory. Taste the finished product, and enjoy lunch on the property.

Capernaum. Step inside the Ancient Synagogue and the House of Peter.

Golan Heights Winery. Treat your palate to Israel's delicious wines.

Focus on Archeology. Stand atop layer upon layer of human occupation at Tel Megiddo's UNESCO status ruins.

Jerusalem's Open Air Market. Browse a bustling kaleidoscope of alleys, stalls, colors and flavors at the Machane Yehuda Market.

Jerusalem. Tour Old Jerusalem, including the Mount of Olives, the Western Wall and the interpretive Davidson Center. See Temple Mount.

A Poignant Monument. Experience the museums and galleries of Yad Vashem, the Holocaust memorial.

Masada. In Masada, join a guided tour to see the fortifications of Herod the Great atop this isolated rock plateau overlooking the Dead Sea. Pause to spend a moment of quiet reflection.

A Sea of Salt. Descend below sea level to Ein Bokek on the Dead Sea.
