Discovery

AHI Connects: Local Dining Club. Relish a private dinner at a Basque gastronomical society, where members socialize and bond over food and drink.

San Sebastián. This lovely resort town is the 2016 European Capital of Culture, noted for its stellar fine dining scene. See its Old Town highlights, including the Neo-Gothic Buen Pastor Cathedral. Stroll on the waterfront promenade for views of beautiful La Concha Bay.

Bayonne. This charming gem, which sits at the confluence of the Adour and Nive rivers, is France's Basque capital. Visit the Gothic Sainte-Marie Cathedral and its cloisters during a walking tour of the Old Town. Relax over lunch at a traditional *cidrerie*, or cider house.

Biarritz. Delight in this chic seaside resort on the Bay of Biscay. Soak up expansive coastal views from above at the city's lighthouse. See the Church of St. Eugenie and walk down to the Rocher del La Vierge, an outcrop that stretches into the Bay.

Bilbao and the Guggenheim Museum. View the exciting modern art at this visually stunning museum, designed by Frank Gehry. Afterward, see the city's landmarks on a panoramic tour and enjoy lunch in Bilbao.

French Basque Traditions and Espelette. Step back in time at Maison Ortillopitz, a 16th-century country home, and learn about Basque family traditions. Continue to Espelette, a picture-perfect town where strands of red peppers adorn whitewashed homes, the traditional method of drying the peppers. Admire its charm on a guided stroll, then relax over lunch.

St-Jean-de-Luz. Journey to this pretty waterfront town with a swashbuckling past. In the 17th and 18th centuries, fishermen traded their nets for swords and cannons to become feared corsairs. Learn about its exciting history on a walking tour that takes you past the Church of St. Jean the Baptist.

Pamplona. With a guide, meander down the town's atmospheric streets, where the chaotic Running of the Bulls occurs each July during the festival of San Fermín. See the bullfighting ring and the Gothic cathedral.

Enrichment

A History of Northern Spain. Understand the important events that have shaped Spanish Basque culture.

Basque Strength Games. Learn about these rural competitions, which feature games based on farming tasks, such as chopping, lifting and sawing.

The Romance of Hemingway and Spain. Appreciate the author's passion for Spain, which influenced his writing.

The Way of St. James. This legendary pilgrimage, with several stops in Basque Country, is both a spiritual and cultural journey. Delve into its lasting popularity.
